JOHANNESBURG & SOWETO COMBO TOUR



Johannesburg City is the gateway to many Southern African tourist hotspots, as well as some local ones like Gold Reef City, many museums and theaters as well as spectacular

botanical gardens. Johannesburg is also known as the City of trees and with 6 million trees, it is one of the largest Urban Jungles in the world. There are 1.2 million trees within the parks and on the pavements, and 4.8 million in private gardens throughout the suburbs.

We pass by Soccer City the amazing football Calabash style stadium. This venue will play host to the opening of the game and final of the 2010 Football World Cup as well as other fixtures. You will have an opportunity to take photos of the development.

We visit this large hostel nearby which has been transformed from migrant labour to informal family accommodation. Baragwanath Taxi & Hospital - Two cooling towers, landmark in Soweto and depicts the lifestyle of the people in Soweto. Drive via Kliptown to Walter Sisulu square of dedication towards on the informal settlements see the shanty huts and see what poverty is.

Regina Mundi Church (drive by only no entrance) Orlando West, pass Winnie Mandela's residence, Vilakazi Street where two Nobel prize winners lived. Nelson Mandela family residence. The trip continues to neighbouring Orlando West and the Hector Pieterse Memorial, the site of where the student uprisings of '76 began. We visit the fascinating museum, which is a state of the art multi media centre depicting scenes leading up to the student uprising of June 16th 1976 and the eventual transition to democracy in South Africa.
