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MALAY TOUR - KQT-2-13

DAY 1

Depart your country for Johannesburg

Day 2

On arrival at Mpumalanga Airport you will be met by your Tour Guide and transferred to your hotel. Afternoon will be spent at your hotel.

Overnight: Protea Hotel Kruger Gate (B & B, D)

Day 3

To make the most of the day we recommend an early breakfast so as to commence game viewing soon after sunrise. Half of the day will be spent on Safari in search of wild animals. No guarantees can be given that you will encounter the "Big Five" (lion, rhino, elephant, leopard and buffalo), but you are certain of seeing, at very close quarters, an abundance of antelope, birds, mammals and possibly reptiles. We will drive to our other hotel at afternoon.

Overnight: Protea Hotel Kruger Gate (B & B, D)

Day 4

Breakfast will be at your hotel. This day will also be dedicated on Safari in search of wild animals.

Overnight: Malelane Sun (B & B, D)

Day 5

After breakfast, drive to Swaziland. We will visit the Candle or Glass Factory, the Street market and the Swazi Cultural Village

Overnight: Ezulwini Sun (B & B, D)

Day 6

After breakfast we will depart for Shakaland. Enjoy a Traditional Zulu Dance show on arrival.

Overnight: Protea Hotel Shakaland (B & B, D)

Day 7

This morning after breakfast, you will drive along the panoramic Zululand and south to Durban. On arrival continues along the palm-lined Victoria Embankment with its statues and exclusive yacht club to the sugar terminal. We visit the Botanical Gardens before stopping at the Indian Market where you can hunt for bargains.

Overnight at the Balmoral Hotel. (B & B, D)

DAY 8

After a delightful breakfast we will depart for Southbroom where we will visit the crocodile farm will spend the day at leisure.

Overnight: Paradise Holiday Resort, (B & B, D)

DAY 9

After an early breakfast we will depart for Port Elizabeth. Port Elizabeth is also known as the friendly city and after a brief city orientation tour we head southwards into the heart of the Garden Route. Quick visit to Tzitzikamma, before we travel to Knysna where we embark on a cruise on the Knysna Lagoon. Take in the magnificent views from on-board the ferry.

Overnight at the Protea Hotel Knysna Quays. (B, D)

DAY 10

After a good breakfast it is off to George station for an antique experience, antique steam trains and cars and memorabilia. Travel over the Outeniqua Mountains into the Karoo and visit the world famous Cango Caves where we take a guided tour lasting an hour - full of fascination. Then on to the Crocodile and Cheetah farm, to learn more about these frightening reptiles. A chance to get close to a cheetah if requested. A short drive to the other end of Oudtshoorn brings us to Ostrich country and lunch at the Safari ostrich farm. After all this, the tour of the farm begins. We head down to the fields, where you will have the opportunity to sit on and ride an ostrich. You will also learn more about the breeding habits and of the bygone days, when Oudtshoorn was in the midst's of the 1920's ostrich feather boom.

Overnight in George Protea Hotel King George. (B & B, D)

Day 11

After breakfast we depart along the scenic coastal route. In Mossel Bay we visit the historic Post Office tree and Dias Museum where early navigators left mail for the homebound ships to Europe. Our route to Swellendam is via rolling hills. Swellendam is full of romantic history and we visit the Drosty Museum. Our lunch is at a restaurant in Swellendam (own account). In the afternoon our route takes us through charming Stellenbosch, for a quick wine tasting. Dinner will be at an Indian restaurant.

Overnight at the Capetonian - Cape Town. (B & B, D)

Day 12

After breakfast, you are collected from your hotel and taken directly to the lower Cableway station on the slopes of Table Mountain. Weather permitting; ascend the mountain by aerial cable car (entrance fee excluded). From a height of 1,067 meters view the city and Table Bay below; also Robben Island, the Atlantic Seaboard and most of the spectacular Cape Peninsula. Head down into the Malay Quarter with its narrow cobbled streets and colorful Mosques. Having parked at the top of Government Avenue stroll to the National Gallery and SA Museum. View the Houses of Parliament. Then to the City Hall on the Grand Parade and later a visit to the Castle. Travel via Sea Point, stopping at Camps Bay to view the Twelve Apostles. At Hout Bay, take a boat trip (weather permitting) out to Duiker Island (Seal Island) and witness the thousands of Cape fur seals, cormorants and seagulls that congregate on the island (especially in summer). Drive through the Cape of Good Hope Nature Reserve and on to Cape Point, which lies virtually at the tip of Africa (only Cape Agulhas lies farther to the South. Proceed to witness the large colony of penguins at boulder's beach.

Overnight at the Capetonian - Cape Town. (B & B, D)

DAY 13

Transfer to the Airport for your flight to Johannesburg, in time to connect to your international flight to your home country.
